STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Permit the Investigation of the Financial Affairs
of the Portland Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The municipal officers of the city of Portland or South
2 Portland may at any time, but not oftener than once a year,
3 cause an investigation of the financial affairs of the Port-
4 land Water District by a competent public accountant, to
5 be selected by the municipal officers of the city or cities
6 instigating such investigation, which accountant shall have
7 free access to the books and records of said Portland Water
8 District for the purpose of such investigation, and the city
9 or cities whose municipal officers cause such investigation

10 to be made shall publish the result of such investigation and
11 the report of the accountant who made such investigation,
12 and the cost of such investigation and publication shall be
13 paid by said water district.
