STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Dover and Foxcroft
Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section six of chapter fifty-four of the private and special
2 laws of the State of Maine for the year one thousand nine
3 hundred and five as amended by section two of chapter
4 two hundred and eighty-five of the private and special laws
5 of the State of Maine for the year one thousand nine hun-
6 dred and eleven, is hereby further amended by striking out
7 in the second line thereof the word "amount," and insert-
8 ing in lieu thereof the word 'amounts,' and is hereby further
9 amended by inserting after the word "dollars" in the third

10 line thereof the words 'outstanding at one time,' so that said
11 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 6. Said Dover and Foxcroft Water District is au-
2 thorized to issue its bonds in amounts not exceeding in the
3 aggregate one hundred and seventy-five thousand dollars
4 outstanding at one time, for such purposes and on such
5 terms and conditions as it may deem expedient. Said bonds
6 shall have interest coupons attached. Said bonds shall be
7 signed in behalf of said corporation by its treasurer and
8 countersigned by its assessors, and the coupons attached
9 thereto shall be impressed by the fac simile of the signature
10 of its treasurer. Said bonds shall be a legal obligation of
11 said water district, which is hereby declared to be quasi
12 municipal corporation within the meaning of section fifty-
13 five, chapter forty-six, of the revised statutes, and all the
14 provisions of said section shall be made applicable thereto.
15 Said bonds, it is hereby declared, shall be public funds of
16 the State of Maine, within the meaning of section one of
17 chapter one hundred and sixty-one of the public laws of
18 one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five.'
