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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

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AN ACT to Amend Section Forty-five of Chapter Two Hundred Nineteen of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Twenty-one, Relative to Clerk Hire in the Registry of Deeds for York County.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That portion of section forty-five of chapter two hundred  
2 nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one,  
3 relative to clerk hire in the registry of deeds for York  
4 county, is hereby amended by striking out the words, "two  
5 thousand" in the third line of the sub-paragraph relating  
6 to York county and inserting in lieu thereof the words 'three  
7 thousand,' so that said sub-paragraph of said section when

8 amended shall read as follows:

‘York county, for clerks in the office of register of deeds,  
2 three thousand dollars.’
