**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE**

**AN ACT to Amend Section Ten of Chapter Sixty-four of the
Revised Statutes, Relating to Marriage.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section ten of chapter sixty-four of the revised statutes is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "chapter" in the
3 second line the words 'or the provisions of section one of
4 chapter forty-one of the public laws of nineteen hundred
5 nineteen' so that said section, as amended, shall read as
6 follows:

'Sect. 10. When residents of this state, with intent to
2 evade the provisions of sections one, two and three of this
3 chapter, or the provisions of section one of chapter forty-

4 one of the public laws of nineteen hundred nineteen, and
5 to return and reside here, go into another state or country,
6 and there have their marriage solemnized, and afterwards
7 return and reside here, such marriage is void in this state.'
