STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT Authorizing the Town of York to Raise Money to
Aid the York Public Library Association.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

The inhabitants of the town of York are hereby authorized
2 and empowered to raise and appropriate at any regular or
3 special town meeting duly called and held, a sum of money
4 not exceeding ten dollars for each of its ratable polls in
5 the year next preceding to aid the York Public Library
6 Association in the construction of a library building in said
7 York.
