STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Fix the Salary of the Judge of the Municipal

Court of Pittsfield.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. The judge of the municipal court of Pittsfield

- 2 shall receive a salary from and after July 1st, 1923, of eight
- 3 hundred dollars (\$800) per year, which shall be paid him
- 4 in quarterly payments from the county treasury of Somerset
- 5 county, which shall be in full for his services as such judge.
- 6 All dockets, record books, blanks, and such stationery and
- 7 supplies as are reasonably necessary for the proper admin-
- 8 istration of said court shall be provided by the county of

- 9 Somerset, and all bills therefor shall be audited by the 10 county commissioners of said county.
 - Sect. 2. The municipal officers of the town of Pittsfield 2 shall provide suitable rooms and facilities for the holding 3 of sessions of said court, and all processes shall be made 4 returnable accordingly.
