**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE**

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in Office of Register of Deeds
in County of Penobscot, to Correct Clerical Error.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. In section forty-five of chapter two hundred
2 and nineteen of the public laws of 1921, relating to clerk
3 hire in the office of register of deeds for the county of
4 Penobscot, through a clerical error, the compensation for
5 clerks in the office of register of deeds for said county of
6 Penobscot was fixed at two thousand and eighty dollars,
7 when the intention was to fix the compensation at twenty-
8 eight hundred and eighty dollars. The county commis-
9 sioners of said county of Penobscot have allowed said com-

10 pension to be paid up to the first day of January, 1923,
11 at the rate of twenty-eight hundred and eighty dollars per
12 year.

Sect. 2. The aforesaid acts of said county commissioners
2 of said county of Penobscot, in allowing said compensation
3 to be paid at the rate of twenty-eight hundred and eighty
4 dollars per year up to January 1, 1923, are hereby con-
5 firmed, legalized and made valid.
