STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of Clerks in the Office of Register of Probate for Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That so much of section forty-five of chapter one hundred 2 and seventeen of the revised statutes as refers to salaries 3 of clerks in the office of register of probate for Hancock 4 county, as amended by section forty-five of chapter two 5 hundred and fourteen of laws of nineteen hundred and 6 seventeen, is hereby further amended by striking out the

7 words "six hundred and twenty-four dollars" and inserting 8 in the place thereof the words 'seven hundred and eighty 9 dollars,' so that said section when amended shall read as 10 follows:

'For clerks in the office of register of deeds, fifteen hun-2 dred dollars; for clerks in the office of register of probate, 3 seven hundred and eighty dollars; for clerks in the office 4 of clerk of courts, seven hundred and eighty dollars.'
