STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Appropriations Made in Favor of the Department of Agriculture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All appropriations except for salaries, made in favor of

- 2 the department of agriculture, shall be considered as one
- 3 appropriation and shall be allotted by the commissioner of
- 4 agriculture to any work necessary in his judgment to be
- 5 done by the department, regardless of the particular line
- 6 of work for which such appropriation is made.
