## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Mary S. Hillman for State Pension.

Resolved: That there be paid to Mary S. Hillman of 2 Island Falls, the sum of three hundred dollars per annum, 3 payable quarterly, until further order of the legislature.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

A state pension has been given for the past six years to Mrs. Hillman, who is the widow of Deputy Sheriff Hillman, who was believed to have been killed in the performance of his official duty. Her circumstances still are such that she needs assistance.
