### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Maine School for Feeble-Minded for Maintenance for the Years Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-four and Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-five.

*Resolved:* That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for 2 the Maine School for Feeble-Minded:

1923-1924 1924-1925

For personal services, namely, for sal-

aries and wages of all officers and employees for two years; July first, nineteen hundred twenty-three, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, the sum of seventyeight thousand dollars, July first, nineteen hundred twenty-four, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred twenty-five, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars.

- For maintenance, namely, for food supplies, wearing apparel, material and supplies incident to maintaining the institution and patients thereof for the two years; July first, nineteen hundred twenty-three, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred twentyfour, the sum of seventy-four thousand dollars, July first, nineteen hundred twenty-four, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred twenty-five, the sum of ninety-five thousand dollars.
- For repairs and equipment, namely, all materials and supplies required for upkeep of grounds, buildings and attached fixtures; all additions to and repairs and replacements of furniture and equipment and live stock, and all personal services rendered wholly in connection with repair work for the two years; July

Provided, that any balance of the sums above appropri-2 ated for the year July first, nineteen hundred twenty-three, 3 to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred twenty-four, which 4 may remain unexpended at the end of the year shall be 5 available for expenditure during the year July first, nine-6 teen hundred twenty-four, to June thirtieth, nineteen hun-7 dred twenty-five, and provided further, that the governor 8 and council may, by order, upon recommendation of the 9 trustees of said institution, authorize the use of unexpended 10 balances of any of the above appropriations to meet defici-11 encies in other appropriations for the same institution.
