IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Section Two of Chapter Three Hundred Nineteen, Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Fifteen, as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred Forty-three, Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Nineteen, Relating to State and County Aid in the Construction of Highway Bridges.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section two of chapter three hundred nineteen, public

laws of nineteen hundred fifteen, as amended by chapter

two hundred forty-three, public laws of nineteen hundred

nineteen, is hereby further amended by inserting after the

word "construction" in the thirteenth line the words, 'and

6 in said board so constituted the town, county and state high-7 way commission shall each have one vote only,' so that said 8 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. When the municipal officers of any town deem 2 that any bridge on any main thoroughfare must be built 3 or rebuilt and in their judgment the expense of the con-4 struction will entitle the municipality to state and county 5 aid as provided in section one of this act, they shall petition 6 the commissioners of the county or counties in which said 7 bridge is, or may be built or rebuilt and the state highway 8 commission to meet with them for the purpose of examin-9 ing into and determining whether public convenience and 10 necessity require the building or rebuilding of said bridge; II said petition to be accompanied by such plans of survey 12 as may be directed to be made by the state highway com-13 mission. The said municipal officers together with the 14 county commissioners and the state highway commission, 15 shall constitute a board to determine the necessity of build-16 ing or rebuilding said bridge, and the form of its construc-17 tion, and in said board so constituted the town, county and 18 state highway commission shall each have one vote only. 19 Said board shall keep or cause to be kept a written record 20 of its doings, including its findings as to preliminary facts 21 necessary to its organization and jurisdiction. The decision 22 of said board, or a majority thereof, upon any matter within 23 its jurisdiction shall be final and conclusive, and the record 24 of its findings upon all preliminary matters shall be prima 25 facie evidence of the truth thereof. The state highway 26 commission shall appoint times and places for meetings of 27 said board and give such reasonable notice thereof as they 28 shall see fit.'
