AN ACT to Secure Prosecution Against Bail in Criminal Cases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

It shall be the duty of the several county attorneys to
2 enforce by scire facias against principal and sureties the
3 penalties on recognizances in criminal cases wherein default
4 has been entered of record; the taxable costs and disburse-
5 ments in such proceedings shall be paid from the county
6 treasury of the county in which such scire facias proceed-
7 ings are brought and the county attorney shall be paid
8 from such county treasury ten per cent of the amount re-
9 covered in such proceedings instituted by him in addition
10 to other compensation allowed by law, any other statute
11 to the contrary notwithstanding.
