STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT Amending Chapter Four Hundred and Forty-nine of the Private and Special Laws of 1865 Entitled, "An Act to Incorporate the Irish American Relief Association of Portland."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section two of chapter four hundred and forty-nine of the
2 private and special laws of 1865 is hereby amended by
3 adding thereto the following words: 'Whenever two-thirds
4 of all of the members of said corporation shall at a meeting
5 specially called for the purpose determine that the purposes
6 for which this corporation was organized have been accom7 plished, the corporation may direct the distribution of the

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8 funds and property of the corporation among its members. 9 The notice of the meeting shall be published in one of the 10 daily newspapers published in the city of Portland at least 11 ten days before the day of meeting. The notice shall 12 clearly state the purpose of the meeting, and the time and 13 place when and where the meeting shall be held. The vote 14 shall be taken by written ballot.'

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
