IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Revised Statutes Chapter One Hundred Seventeen Section Forty-five as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred Fourteen, Public Laws 1919 as Further Amended by Chapter Two Hundred Nineteen of Public Laws of 1921, Restoring the Amount for Clerk Hire in Office of Register of Probate in Washington County to Same Rate as in Nineteen Hundred Twenty-two and the Three Years Preceding

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter one hundred and seventeen, section forty-five, of
2 the revised statutes as amended by chapter two hundred
3 and fourteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred and
4 nineteen and as further amended by chapter two hundred

5 and nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred and
6 twenty-one is hereby amended by striking out the follow-
7 ing words "after January first, nineteen hundred and
8 twenty-three, four hundred dollars" in the third and fourth
9 lines of that part of said section relating to Washington
10 county and inserting in place thereof 'from and after Jan-
11 uary first nineteen hundred and twenty-three' so that said
12 part of said section, as amended, shall read as follows :

'Washington county: For clerks in the office of register
2 of deeds, seven hundred and eighty dollars; for clerks in
3 the office of register of probate, seven hundred and eighty
4 dollars from and after January first nineteen hundred and
5 twenty-three; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts,
6 seven hundred and eighty dollars; for expenses of clerk
7 of courts and his subordinates while attending session of
8 supreme judicial court at Calais, such sums as may be
9 allowed by the court.'
