RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Repair Eastport Bridge.

EMERGENCY PREAMBLE

Whereas, the long bridge between the city of Eastport and the town of Perry in this state is out of repair and its condition such as to constitute a menace to the safety of travelers thereon and extensive repair thereof is immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety;

And whereas, the foregoing facts constitute an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of this state; now therefore,

Resolved: That the sum of thirty-five thousand dollars 2 or as much thereof as may be necessary, be and hereby is

- 3 appropriated to repair and rebuild the bridge between the
- 4 city of Eastport and the town of Perry in the county of
- 5 Washington, same to be expended under the direction of
- 6 the state highway commission.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE

In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.
