AN ACT to Amend Section Forty-five, Chapter One Hundred Seventeen, Revised Statutes, as Amended in 1917, 1919 and 1921, Relating to Clerk Hire in Office of Clerk of Courts in Waldo County.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That paragraph of section forty-five of chapter one hundred seventeen of the revised statutes, which relates to clerk hire in Waldo county, is hereby amended by striking out the words "five hundred" in the third line and inserting in place thereof the words 'seven hundred,' so that said paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

'Waldo county: for clerks in the office of register of  
2 deeds, seven hundred eighty dollars; for clerks in the  
3 office of register of probate, one hundred dollars; for  
4 clerks in the office of clerk of courts, seven hundred dollars.'
