IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Aid of Navigation on Moosehead Lake.

---

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the  
2 sum of one thousand dollars for the year from July first,  
3 nineteen hundred twenty-three to June thirtieth, nineteen  
4 hundred twenty-four, and one thousand dollars for the  
5 year from July first, nineteen hundred twenty-four to June  
6 thirtieth, nineteen hundred twenty-five, for the purpose of  
7 installing and re-locating lights and buoys on and about  
8 Moosehead lake to aid in the navigation thereon. The  
9 same to be expended under the direction of the public  
10 utilities commission.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

For a number of years there has been no replacement to correct position of the buoys marking rocks, reefs and channels on Moosehead lake.

There is need of many new buoys to mark the whereabouts of dangerous rocks. It is also necessary that the lights on Mile island and the various wharves be maintained.
