STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in favor of Charles E. Bradford, for State
Pension.

Resolved: That the sum of twelve dollars per month be
2 paid to Charles E. Bradford of Carmel, payable quarterly
3 from the fund appropriated for soldiers' pensions, beginning
4 January first, nineteen hundred twenty-three, and continu-
5 ing during the pleasure of the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Bradford is 49 years old, and has locomotor ataxia; cared for by his mother Elizabeth C. Bradford, age 76, a Civil War widow. She receives a pension of \$30 per month. His father enlisted July 22, 1862 in the first Maine H. A. discharged December 15, 1864, died March 18, 1918. His mother is in very poor health.
