STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Section Thirty-nine, Chapter One Hundred Seventeen, Revised Statutes, as Amended in Nineteen Hundred Seventeen, Nineteen Hundred Nineteen and Nineteen Hundred Twenty-one, Relative to Salaries of Registers of Probate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section thirty-nine of chapter one hundred seventeen of
2 the revised statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred
3 sixty-seven, public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen,
4 chapter two hundred fourteen, public laws of nineteen hun5 dred nineteen and chapter two hundred nineteen, public
6 laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one, is hereby further

7 amended by striking out the words "one thousand" in the 8 eighteenth line and inserting in place thereof the words 9 'twelve hundred,' so that said section as amended shall read 10 as follows:

'Sect. 39. Registers of probate in the several counties 2 shall receive annual salaries from the treasuries of the coun-3 ties in monthly payments paid on the last day of each month, 4 as follows:

Androscoggin, sixteen hundred dollars, Aroostook, fifteen hundred dollars, Cumberland, two thousand dollars, Franklin, nine hundred dollars, Hancock, one thousand dollars, Kennebec, eighteen hundred dollars, Knox, twelve hundred fifty dollars, Lincoln, nine hundred dollars, Oxford, fifteen hundred dollars, Penobscot, eighteen hundred dollars, Piscataquis, twelve hundred dollars, Sagadahoc, one thousand dollars, Somerset fifteen hundred dollars, Waldo, twelve hundred dollars. Washington, one thousand dollars, York, fifteen hundred dollars.

The sums above mentioned shall be in full compensation 2 for the performance of all duties required of registers of 3 probate.'
