STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, for State Pension for Rena Cooley.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated 2 the sum of two hundred dollars for the year ending June 3 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-four and the sum of 4 two hundred dollars for the year ending June thirtieth, 5 nineteen hundred and twenty-five, to be paid in quarterly 6 payments of fifty dollars each to Rena Cooley of Augusta, 7 for and in behalf of herself and her minor children, Violet 8 and Evelyn, under the supervision of the governor and 9 council.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Cooley was left a widow with her two minor girls when her husband, for a long time an employee at the Augusta state hospital, was assaulted and killed by one of the inmates.
