STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, for State Pension for Annie D. McLean.

RESOLVED: That there be paid to Annie D. McLean 2 of Augusta a pension of three hundred dollars for the fiscal 3 year beginning July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-4 three, and three hundred dollars for the fiscal year beginning July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, payable 6 monthly from money in the state treasury not otherwise 7 appropriated.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Annie D. McLean for whom claim is made for state pension is a resident of Augusta and worked continuously at the Augusta State Hospital nearly thirty-four years—from August twenty-ninth, eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, to May twentieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two.

Mrs. McLean was obliged to give up her employment because of ill health and has never received any pension under the general law.
