# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Olive E. Brann of Augusta for State
Pension.

Resolved: That there be paid to Olive E. Brann of 2 Augusta the sum of twelve (\$12) dollars per month, pay-3 able quarterly from the fund appropriated for soldiers' 4 pensions, beginning January one, nineteen hundred and 5 twenty-three and continuing during the pleasure of the 6 legislature.
