STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT amending section 23 of Chapter 26 of the Revised Statutes relating to Registration of Automobiles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. Section twenty-three of chapter twenty-six of
2 the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the
3 period in the forty second line thereof and substituting
4 therefor a comma, and adding the following words: 'and a
5 registration card of such design as the secretary of state
6 may determine.'

Sect. 2. Said section twenty-three is hereby further 2 amended by adding after the word "engine" in the forty 3 third line thereof the following words: 'The registration

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4 card shall state the name, place of residence and post office 5 address of the registrant, and shall bear the signature of the 6 registrant and the signature of the secretary of state. The 7 card shall briefly describe the motor vehicle registered, and 8 shall state the name of the maker and the number (if any) 9 affixed by the maker, the character of the motive power, and 10 the amount of such power (stated in figures of horse 11 power). Said registration card shall bear the same number 12 as the number plate and shall be so fastened to the auto-13 mobile that it may be easily read.'
