STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Good Templar's Hall in Dexter.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That the selectmen of Dexter in their capacity
2 of trustees under chapter forty-eight of the private and
3 special laws of eighteen hundred eighty-one are hereby au-
4 thorized to convey to Plymouth Lodge of Dexter, Number
5 Sixty-five, Independent Order of Odd Fellows, all the in-
6 terest in them vested as trustees as aforesaid in that build-
7 ing in Dexter, which contains the Good Templar's Hall in
8 Dexter, including their interest in the lot on which it stands.

Sect. 2. Funds received from the sale of said property
2 shall be deposited in the town treasury of Dexter to be in-

3 vested by said trustees and to be called the Temperance
4 Fund, to which donations may be added from time to time
5 by other parties. The town of Dexter shall be responsible
6 for the safe custody of the funds. The income from such
7 fund shall be paid semi-annually to the Women's Christian
8 Temperance Union of Dexter or its successors for use in
9 the promotion of the cause of temperance.
