STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT for the Better Protection of Clams within the Limits of the Town of Roque Bluffs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Clams in Roque Bluffs to be taken for com-

- 2 mercial purposes by residents only. It shall be unlawful
- 3 for any person not a resident of the Town of Roque Bluffs
- 4 in the County of Washington to dig clams for commercial
- 5 purposes within the limits of said town.

Sect. 2. Non-residents may take clams for home consump-

- 2 tion. Persons not residents of the Town of Roque Bluffs
- 3 may be permitted to dig for clams for fish bait or home
- 4 consumption within the limits of said town; provided, how-

- 5 ever, that no person shall dig for purposes mentioned in 6 this section during any one day more than one bushel of 7 clams.
- Sect. 3. Penalty for violation. Whoever violates the pro-2 visions of sections one and two of this act shall for each 3 offense be punished by a fine not exceeding twenty-five dol-4 lars, or by imprisonment for not more than thirty days.
