STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Section Three and Paragraph Seven of
Section Four of Chapter One Hundred of the Private and
Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-one, Relat-
ing to Belgrade Lakes Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section three of chapter one hundred of the
2 private and special laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one
3 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "corpora-
4 tion" in the fourth line the words 'provided, however, that
5 the trustees shall have no power or authority to appropriate
6 money for any purpose or to make contracts unless duly
7 authorized by a majority vote of the legal voters of said

8 corporation present and voting at a meeting of said corpora-
9 tion duly called therefor,' so that said section, as amended,
10 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 3. At any time after this act goes into effect a
2 meeting of this corporation can be called by five of the in-
3 habitants posting a written notice giving fourteen days'
4 warning of the date of the first meeting. At the first meet-
5 ing there shall be elected three trustees to manage the af-
6 fairs of the corporation, provided, however, that the trus-
7 tees shall have no power or authority to appropriate money
8 for any purpose or to make contracts unless duly author-
9 ized by a majority vote of the legal voters of said corpora-
10 tion present and voting at a meeting of said corporation
11 duly called therefor. The trustees shall hold office for one
12 year and until their successors are elected. Any meeting of
13 the corporation can be called after the first organization by
14 at least two of the trustees posting a notice seven days be-
15 fore the date of the meeting. Any trustees elected to fill
16 a vacancy shall only serve for the unexpired term. The
17 trustees shall annually elect one of their members treas-
18 urer and shall designate the amount of compensation he
19 shall receive.'

Sect. 2. Paragraph seven of section four is hereby amend-
2 ed by striking out all of said paragraph and inserting in place
3 thereof the following:

'Paragraph VII. The town of Belgrade shall annually pay
2 over to the treasurer of said corporation out of the taxes

3 collected from the inhabitants and estates in said Belgrade
4 Lakes Village, a sum equal to twenty per centum of all
5 the town taxes, exclusive of the state and county tax, col-
6 lected from said inhabitants and estates of said Belgrade
7 Lakes Village Corporation.'
