STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Section Three of Chapter Two Hundred Sixty-four of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Nineteen, as Amended by Chapter One Hundred of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Twenty-one, Relating to Applications for Soldiers' Bonus.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section three of chapter two hundred sixty-four of the

public laws of nineteen hundred nineteen, as amended by

chapter one hundred of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one, is hereby further amended by striking out

the word "twenty-two" in the third line and inserting in

6 place thereof the word 'twenty-four,' so that said section 7 as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 3. Applications for such bonus shall be filed with 2 the adjutant general, on forms provided by him, before the 3 first day of January, nineteen hundred twenty-four. Such 4 application shall state facts sufficient to establish the status 5 of such applicant as soldier as defined herein, and shall be 6 duly verified.'
