## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Paragraph Seven of Section Forty-five of Chapter One Hundred Seventeen of the Revised Statutes as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred Fourteen of Public Laws of 1919 as Further Amended by Chapter Two Hundred Nineteen of the Public Laws of 1921, Relating to Amount Allowed for Clerk Hire in Offices of Register of Deeds and Register of Probate in Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Paragraph seven of section forty-five of chapter one hun-2 dred seventeen of the revised statutes as amended by 3 chapter two hundred fourteen of public laws of nineteen 4 hundred and nineteen as further amended by chapter two

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5 hundred nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred 6 and twenty-one, is hereby amended by striking out the 7 words "twenty-three hundred dollars" in the first and second 8 lines of said paragraph and inserting in place thereof the 9 words 'twenty-five hundred dollars' and by striking out the 10 words "seven hundred and eighty dollars" in the second 11 and third lines of said paragraph and inserting in place 12 thereof the words 'one thousand and forty dollars,' so that 13 said paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

'Kennebec County: for clerks in the office of register of 2 deeds, twenty-five hundred dollars; for clerks in the office 3 of register of probate, one thousand and forty dollars; for 4 clerks in the office of clerk of courts, fifteen hundred dol-5 lars.'
