## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Provide for Safeguarding from Damage from Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

As a condition precedent to the issuance of any registra-2 tion for a motor vehicle to be operated upon the highways 3 of the state of Maine, the applicant shall satisfy the secre-4 tary of state either by personal bond or indemnity bond 5 running to the secretary of state condition to pay any and 6 all damages resulting from the negligence in operation of 7 said motor vehicle, which bond shall be in the sum of five 8 thousand dollars.
