STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Provide for Safeguarding from Damage from
Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

As a condition precedent to the issuance of any registration for a motor vehicle to be operated upon the highways of the state of Maine, the applicant shall satisfy the secretary of state either by personal bond or indemnity bond running to the secretary of state condition to pay any and all damages resulting from the negligence in operation of said motor vehicle, which bond shall be in the sum of five thousand dollars.
