STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT in Regard to Discharge of Mortgages.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. A discharge written upon a mortgage and
2 properly signed by the party authorized to discharge said
3 mortgage shall be effective without seal and entitled to
4 record without acknowledgment.

Sect. 2. This act shall apply to discharges heretofore as 2 well as those hereafter made.
