### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Incontestable Clause in Life Insurance Policies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That the policy of insurance together with the appli-2 cation therefor, a copy of which application shall be 3 endorsed upon or attached to the policy and made a part 4 thereof, shall constitute the entire contract between the 5 parties and shall be incontestable after it shall have been 6 in force during the life time of the insured for two years 7 from its date, except for non-payment of premiums and 8 except for violations of the policy relating to the naval or 9 military service in time of war and at the option of the 10 company provisions relative to benefits in the event of total 11 and permanent disability and provisions which grant additional insurance specifically against death by accident may 13 also be excepted.

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
