RESOLVE, Granting the Consent of the State to the Building
of a Bridge Between "Big Five Island" and "Hen Island"
in the Town of Georgetown.

Resolved: That the consent of the state of Maine is here-
2 by given to the owners of "Big Five Island" and "Hen
3 Island" in the town of Georgetown to build a bridge con-
4 necting said islands, subject, however, to permission being
5 granted by the federal government.
