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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

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RESOLVE, Authorizing the Treasurer of State to Accept  
from the Executors of the Will of John Prescott, Two Five  
Hundred Dollar United States Liberty Bonds in Lieu of the  
Legacy of One Thousand Dollars Left by Said Prescott to  
the Western Maine Sanatorium at Hebron.

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Resolved: That the treasurer of state be and hereby is  
2 authorized to receive from the executors of the will of the  
3 late John Prescott two five hundred dollar United States  
4 Liberty bonds in lieu of the sum of one thousand dollars  
5 bequeathed to the Western Maine Sanatorium at Hebron  
6 by said Prescott, to be held by said treasurer of state for  
7 the use and benefit of said Western Maine Sanatorium as

8 specified in said bequest, and the action of said treasurer  
9 of state in receiving said bonds and issuing receipts there-  
10 for is hereby approved and made valid.
