IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Care, Maintenance and Repairs of Fort William Henry in the Town of Bristol.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for 2 the fiscal year from July first, nineteen hundred twenty-3 three, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred twenty-four, the 4 sum of three hundred dollars for salary of custodian and 5 the sum of five hundred dollars for purchase of additional 6 land at said fort; and for the fiscal year from July first, 7 nineteen hundred twenty-four, to June thirtieth, nineteen 8 hundred twenty-five, the sum of three hundred dollars for 9 salary of custodian and the sum of two hundred dollars for 10 repairs; said sums to be expended under the direction of 11 the commissioners of the state in charge of said fort.
