STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT for the Better Protection of Smelts in the Damariscotta River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section I. No smelts shall be taken or fished for in the
2 Damariscotta river or its tributaries in any other way than
3 by hook and line above a line drawn from Farnham's Head
4 in the town of Boothbay to a point opposite on the shore
5 in the town of South Bristol, under a penalty of one hun6 dred dollars for each offense.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith 2 are hereby repealed.
