**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE**

AN ACT to Amend Section Nineteen of Chapter Ninety-eight,
Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Twenty-one, Relating to
Suspension and Revocation of Lobster Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section nineteen of chapter ninety-eight of the public laws
2 of nineteen hundred twenty-one is hereby amended by strik-
3 ing out the words "be employed by another or" and the
4 words "lobster business" in the eleventh line and inserting
5 after the word "the" in the eleventh line the words 'catch-
6 ing of lobsters,' so that said section as amended shall read
7 as follows:

'Sect. 19. If any person, firm, or corporation to whom

2 such license shall be granted shall be incapacitated for any
3 reason, except for the violation of the laws of the state
4 relating to the lobster industry from using said license, said
5 person, firm or corporation may permit his agent or em-
6 ployee, if a citizen of this state, to perform such duties
7 under the license as may be necessary during the period
8 of his or its incapacity; provided that said agent or em-
9 ployee shall, when performing said duties so licensed, ex-
10 hibit upon demand of any authorized person, the certificate
11 issued to his superior, as provided in the preceding section.
12 No person whose license has been revoked or suspended
13 shall assist in the catching of lobsters in any way. Every
14 person who shall violate the provisions of this section shall
15 upon conviction be subject to the fines and penalties pro-
16 vided in section seventeen.'
