STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Section Twenty-five of Chapter One Hundred and Twenty-four of the Revised Statutes, Relating to Penalty for Falsely Assuming to be an Officer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section twenty-five of chapter one hundred and twenty-

- 2 four of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking
- 3 out the entire section and by inserting in place thereof the
- 1 following:

'Sect. 25. Whoever falsely assumes to be a justice of the

- 2 peace, sheriff, deputy sheriff, health inspector or health offi-
- 3 cer, coroner or constable, inland fish and game warden, com-
- 4 missioner of inland fisheries and game or state highway

5 police and who acts as such or who requires anyone to aid 6 him in a matter pertaining to the duties of such office, shall 7 be punished by imprisonment for not less than one year or 8 by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars or more than 9 five hundred dollars, or by both fine and imprisonment.'
