## STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Section Eighteen of Chapter Forty-five of the Revised Statutes, as Amended by Section Two of Chapter Ninety-eight of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Twenty-one, Relating to the Issuing of Lobster Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

An Act to amend section eighteen of chapter forty-five of 2 the revised statutes as amended by section two of chapter 3 ninety-eight of the public laws of nineteeen hundred twenty-4 one, by striking out after the word "license" in the eighth 5 line all of said sentence in said amendment so that said 6 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 18. The director of sea and shore fisheries shall 2 grant and issue licenses in the lobster industry. Such 3 licenses shall be divided into four classes, namely: First 4 class, fishermen's licenses; second class, selling licenses; 5 third class, shipping licenses; and fourth class, smackmen's 6 licenses. Licenses of the first class, fishermen's licenses, 7 shall be issued only to citizens of this state or to any per-8 son who has resided within the state continuously for one 9 year, immediately preceding the date of application for 10 license. Licenses of the second class, selling licenses, shall 11 be issued only to persons, firms, or corporations conducting 12 hotels, restaurants, or boarding houses, or to persons, firms 13 or corporations engaged in the business of buying and sell-14 ing lobsters. Licenses of the third class, shippers' licenses, 15 shall be issued only to persons, firms or corporations en-16 gaged in the lobster business in this state or other states 17 to buy, sell and ship lobsters. Licenses of the fourth class. 18 smackmen's licenses, shall be issued only to smackmen to 19 buy, sell and transport lobsters by smack or boat. All 20 licenses now outstanding shall become void on the passage 21 of this act and new licenses must be obtained under the 22 conditions herein set forth. Applications for licenses shall 23 be made upon special forms provided by the director of 24 sea and shore fisheries. Violations of the agreements of 25 the application shall render the license thereon void. Dump-26 ing, destroying or removing any bag, box or other recep-27 tacle after command of the director of sea and shore fish-

28 eries or his wardens, or when pursued by the director of 29 sea and shore fisheries or his wardens shall be evidence of 30 violation of the agreement of his application and the license 31 of such person shall be revoked. The said director shall 32 keep the clerks of various cities, towns and plantations bor-33 dering on the sea shore and other clerks who request them, 34 supplied with blank applications; said clerk shall keep a 35 supply of them on hand and furnish them to applicants. 36 All applications when filled out shall be forwarded to the 37 office of said director together with fees for same. Such 38 licenses shall be granted to expire on the last day of June 39 next succeeding the granting of same, unless sooner re-40 voked, as provided in section twenty. The director in his 41 biennial report shall state the number of licenses granted. 42 He shall issue to each person, firm or corporation licensed 43 as aforesaid a certificate, stating the name of the person, 44 firm or corporation to whom such license shall be granted, 45 the number of said license and the date of expiration of 46 said license.'
