RESOLVE, Providing a State Pension for Hattie C. Knowlton  
of Liberty.

---

Resolved: That there be paid to Hattie C. Knowlton of  
2 Liberty, a pension of twelve dollars per month, payable  
3 quarterly, beginning January first, nineteen hundred twen-  
4 ty-three, and continuing during the pleasure of the legis-  
5 lature and until otherwise ordered.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Hattie C. Knowlton is forty-four years of age, has been blind from a child, was never married, mother died in 1911 and she has no means of support with the exception of a state pension of \$15.00 per month for the blind. Her father died January 4, 1923, a late member of Co. G, 1st Me. Cavalry, leaving his daughter Hattie without means of support. She is of unsound mind and requires constant care.
