**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE**

**AN ACT to Authorize the Town of Southport to Construct
a Bridge Over the Tide-waters to Joe Island Gut.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The inhabitants of the town of Southport are authorized
2 and empowered to locate and construct a bridge from the
3 mainland to Joe Island across the tide-waters of Joe Island
4 gut. Said bridge to be located by a vote of the town at
5 a regular or special meeting duly called and held after this
6 act takes effect, on one of the following locations: First
7 location. Beginning on land of Hodgdon and Nickerson
8 heirs in the town of Southport and extending across the tide-
9 waters of Joe Island gut to land of Ezra Pratt on said

10 island. Second location. Beginning on land of Nahum
11 W. Brewer in the town of Southport and extending across
12 tide-waters of Joe Island gut to land of Ezra Pratt on Joe
13 island. Said bridge to be constructed and maintained in
14 accordance with the acts of Congress pertaining to bridges
15 and wharves over and across tide-waters and to be main-
16 tained by said town of Southport.
