STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE**

AN ACT to Authorize the City of Lewiston to Issue Its Bonds
to the Amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars to Con-
struct an Armory in the City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

To construct an armory in the city of Lewiston, assisted
2 by state aid, the city of Lewiston is authorized to issue its
3 bonds to an amount not exceeding two hundred thousand
4 dollars, payable at a period not to exceed twenty years and
5 bearing interest at a rate not to exceed four and one-half
6 per cent per annum, payable semi-annually. Said bonds
7 shall be issued in serial form and shall be payable in the
8 following manner, to wit: Ten thousand dollars in one

9 year from date of issuance and ten thousand dollars on
10 each and every year thereafter until said issue is fully paid.

Said bonds shall be issued under the seal of the city and
2 shall be signed by the mayor and treasurer of the city, and
3 the coupons attached thereto shall have the printed or litho-
4 graphed signature of the treasurer.
