House Bill number three hundred and eighty-one is here2 by amended by striking out the word "sheep" in the sev3 enth line and inserting in place thereof the words 'any
4 domestic animal or fowl'; by striking out the word "sheep"
5 in the ninth line and inserting in place thereof the words
6 'any domestic animal or fowl'; by striking out the word
7 "sheep" in the tenth line and inserting in place thereof the
8 words 'any domestic animal or fowl'; by adding after the
9 word "animal" in the thirteenth line the words 'or fowl';
10 and by adding to said section the following words: "The
11 words "domestic animal" as used in this section shall not
12 include dogs or cats.'
