IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Central Maine Sanatorium for Fire Protection.

EMERGENCY PREAMBLE

Whereas, the institution hereinafter referred to is at the present time without any fire protection, and

Whereas, the proper protection of said institution is urgently necessary for the interest of the public peace, health and safety, and in the judgment of this legislature an emergency exists within the means of the constitution of this state, now therefore, be it

Resolved: That there be appropriated for the Central 2 Maine Sanatorium for the providing of adequate fire pro-

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3 tection for its buildings, the sum of twenty thousand dol-4 lars for the period from July first, nineteen hundred and 5 twenty-three, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-6 four. Provided that any portion of the appropriation re-7 maining unexpended shall be available for expenditure dur-8 ing the next fiscal year.

Emergency Clause. In view of the emergency cited above, 2 this resolve shall take effect when approved.
