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**STATE OF MAINE**

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**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE**

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AN ACT to Authorize the City of Lewiston to Issue Its Bonds  
to the Amount of Eighty Thousand Dollars to Refund Its  
Bonds Now Outstanding and Maturing in the Year Nineteen  
Hundred Twenty-four.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

To meet its bonds now outstanding and maturing in the  
2 year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, the City  
3 of Lewiston is authorized to issue bonds to an amount not  
4 exceeding eighty thousand dollars payable at a period or  
5 periods not exceeding sixteen years after the date thereof  
6 and bearing interest at a rate not to exceed four and one-  
7 half per cent per annum, interest payable semi-annually.

8 Said bonds shall be issued in serial form and shall be pay-  
9 able in the following manner, to wit: Five thousand dollars  
10 in one year after the date of issuance and five thousand  
11 dollars on each and every succeeding year until the entire  
12 issue is paid.

Said bonds shall be issued under the seal of the city and  
2 shall be signed by the mayor and treasurer of the city, and  
3 the coupons attached to said bonds shall have the printed or  
4 lithographed signature of the treasurer.
