STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Provide for the Designation and Registration of Farm Names.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. The owner of any farm lands may designate
2 a specific name for such lands and the said name together
3 with a description of said farm lands according to the latest
4 authentic survey thereof may be filed with the register of
5 deeds of the county wherein the said lands or a part thereof
6 are situated, and the said name together with the descrip7 tion of said lands shall be recorded by the register of deeds
8 in a book to be provided for such purpose, upon payment

9 of a fee of fifty cents, but no two names so designated and 10 recorded shall be alike in the same county.

Sect. 2. Whenever any owner of farm lands the name 2 of which has been recorded as provided in this act, trans-3 fers by deed or otherwise the whole of such farm lands, 4 such transfer may include the registered name thereof; but 5 if the owner shall transfer only a portion of such farm 6 lands, then the registered name thereof shall not be trans-7 ferred to the purchaser unless so stated in the deed of con-8 veyance.
