IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Establishment of a
Test Laboratory at Caribou in the County of Aroostook.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of five thousand dollars to be expended by the state
3 department of health under the direction of the governor
4 and council for the purpose of establishing, equipping and
5 maintaining during the years nineteen hundred twenty-three
6 and nineteen hundred twenty-four, of a test laboratory for
7 Aroostook county, same to be located at Caribou.
