RESOLVE, in Favor of Nancy T. Morrill of Madison, Widow of Cyrus D. Morrill, M. D., Who Served in the Quota of Maine in the Civil War.

Resolved: That there be paid to Nancy T. Morrill of Madi-2 son the sum of six dollars per month, payable quarterly, 3 from the fund appropriated for soldiers' pensions, beginning 4 January first, nineteen hundred twenty-three, and continuing 5 for two years.
