STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Section Forty-four of Chapter One Hundred and Seventeen of the Revised Statutes Relating to the Salary of the County Treasurer of Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-four of chapter one hundred seventeen of
2 the revised statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred
3 sixty-seven, public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen,
4 chapters two hundred fourteen and two hundred fifty-nine,
5 public laws of nineteen hundred nineteen, and by chapter
6 two hundred nineteen, public laws of nineteen hundred
7 twenty-one, is hereby further amended by striking out fol-
8 lowing the word "Hancock" in the ninth line, the words

9 “five hundred dollars,” and inserting in place thereof the
10 words ‘six hundred dollars,’ so that said section as amended
11 shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 44. County treasurers in the several counties shall
2 receive annual salaries from the treasuries of the counties
3 in monthly payments paid on the last day of each month,
4 as follows:

Androscoggin, eighteen hundred dollars.

Aroostook, eight hundred dollars.

Cumberland, two thousand dollars.

Franklin, four hundred dollars.

Hancock, six hundred dollars.

Kennebec, fifteen hundred dollars.

Knox, four hundred dollars.

Lincoln, three hundred dollars.

Oxford, six hundred fifty dollars.

Penobscot, eighteen hundred dollars.

Piscataquis, five hundred dollars.

Sagadahoc, five hundred dollars.

Somerset, six hundred dollars.

Waldo, four hundred dollars.

Washington, seven hundred dollars.

York, eight hundred fifty dollars.

Each of the counties above named shall pay the premium
2 on the official bonds of its treasurer.’
